



FUTURE PRESENTER AWARD

This prize will be awarded to a promising presenter with some experience – for example with student TV or on their own YouTube channel – but no professional credits or representation.

ENTERING

- The fee to enter the award is £20.
- All fees are payable via Stripe after submission. You will receive a link to pay in your confirmation email and entries will not be considered until payment has been made.
- The entry fee covers the costs of processing and assessing submissions, and we do not give refunds.
- If you are unable to pay the entry fee, email talentschemes@thetvfestival.com and we will provide you with a waiver code.
- Entries must be submitted by 10am on 15th February 2023.

QUESTION LIST

To enter this award you will need to provide the following:

- **Contact details.** We will need your:
 - Name
 - Email address
 - Phone number
- **Entry details.** We will require you to submit:
 - A link to your **presenting showreel**. Wherever possible, this should be on an account (dropbox/ wetransfer/ vimeo/ youtube etc) which you control. Make sure the link remains live until the end of March 2023 - if the link doesn't work, we can't assess or shortlist your entry. We won't be judging you on the editing of your showreel – several clips back to back is fine but try to keep it under 10 minutes.
 - A short bit of writing **telling us about your ambitions as a presenter...** What impact do you want to make on the TV industry? What kind of programmes do you want to make or work on? Your answer should be no more than 150 words. We will not be judging the quality of your writing, but are keen to know more about you and what you want to do in TV.
- **Marketing questions**
 - Where did you hear about the awards?

- Social handles – we'll use these to tag you in posts across our social media should you be shortlisted.
- **Equal Opportunities Monitoring information**
 - The questions in this section are asked for the purposes of statistical monitoring. If you are entering on behalf of someone else and do not have this information simply select 'prefer not to say' for all questions.
 - The information you give here will not be part of the assessment process and will be kept separate from your entry.
 - The TV Foundation aims to improve access to careers in TV and support a diverse talent pipeline, and the information we get from this section will be analysed to help us ensure that we are reaching people from all regions and backgrounds in our outreach for the awards.
 - All of the information we collect is processed in accordance with General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) and any other applicable data protection legislation in the UK. No third parties will be given access to the personal information provided unless we are required by law to do so.
 - You can help us by answering these questions. If you prefer not to, you can select that option when completing the section.

ELIGIBILITY

- Entrants must be 18 years of age or older.
- Entrants must not have had previous credits as a presenter on any broadcast, paid presenting experience or representation as a presenter by the time of application.
- International entrants are eligible but entrants must reside primarily in the UK.
- Eligibility will be verified at the shortlisting stage. If you no longer meet these criteria at any point – for example if you are hired for a professional presenting job, or you sign with an agent – you will be responsible for informing us as soon as possible and will have to withdraw from the process.

AWARDS PROCESS

- Winning entrants will be selected by a jury of writers and TV professionals.
- Phone interviews may be conducted at shortlisting stage.
- The winner will be announced at The New Voice Awards on the 6th April 2023.
- The winner will be awarded one free pass to the Edinburgh Television Festival, and three nights' accommodation for one person in Edinburgh. Other prizes may be announced at a later date.
- The winner will be supported by The TV Foundation for 12 months following winning and become part of the TV Foundation's alumni network.

- By entering you are giving permission to the Edinburgh TV Festival to reproduce stills and clips of selected entries, for all Edinburgh TV Festival publications, trailers, press and TV coverage, and social media channels.
